# **International Mandate - UNCED**

The globally harmonized hazard classification and compatible labeling system, including safety data sheets (SDS) and easily understandable symbols

#### What is the current situation?

- Suppliers must apply multiple classifications to chemical products
  - o For various end uses within countries
  - o For shipment to other countries for use there
- Multiple Labels and SDS's for the same product

#### What is the GHS?

- Common approach to classifying & communicating hazards
- New 16 section SDS similar to ANSI
- GHS SDS contains environmental and transport information

### What will Change

- More products will be classified as hazardous
- More products classified as dangerous goods for transport
- All chemical products will require reevaluation & reclassification
- All SDS will Change
- All Labels will Change
